PARTICIPATION AS EXHIBITOR: GENERAL TERMS AND CONDITIONS

First: Organization

EXPOSESECURITY® 2026 is organized by Exposecurity World S.L., the entity appointed to promote the support services necessary for the commercialization and material execution of the event.

Second: Purpose of the contract

The purpose of this contract is participation as an exhibitor in the EXPOSESECURITY 2026 event, to be held at the Pabellón de Cristal in Casa de Campo on November 5, 6 and 7, 2026, from 10:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m.

This contract shall enter into force upon its formalization and shall remain in effect until the end of the event.

The basic services included for the exhibitor are:

- Space rental
- Mandatory insurance (Civil Liability and Damage Insurance)
- Exhibitor passes
- Invitations
- Welcome set

These services may be expanded depending on the participation options set out in section seven of these General Terms and Conditions.

Third: Applicable regulations

The contracting and participation regulations for EXPOSESECURITY 2026 consist of the provisions and rules contained in the following documents:

- This EXPOSESECURITY 2026 Participation Form
- The EXPOSESECURITY 2026 Exhibitor Guide
- The annexed forms thereto, which will be available closer to the date of participation in the event

Fourth: Participation

All companies, institutions and entities whose activities are included in the sectors subject to demonstration may participate in EXPOSESECURITY 2026.

The Organization reserves the right to exclude any party that engages in unfair competition or any other infringement of the legal system, as well as any party that fully or partially assigns or subleases the contracted space.

Fifth: Event dates and opening hours

The Fair will be held on November 5, 6 and 7, 2026, continuously from 10:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m.

Outside these hours, the presence of visiting public is prohibited, except for duly accredited stand staff, who may access the venue from 9:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m.

Sixth: Contracting process and EXPOSESECURITY 2026 email service

To contract your space as an exhibitor at EXPOSESECURITY 2026, you must complete the following process:

1. Complete the Exhibitor Participation Form provided by the Organization.
2. The Organization will validate the data received and, if everything is correct, will proceed to send you the invoice for the first payment, in accordance with the deadlines explained below in general condition eight.
3. Once the invoice has been paid, you must send the payment or bank transfer receipt to the Organization at info@exposecurity.net. You have 30 days to do so. If this period expires without the receipt having been received, your Exhibitor Participation Form will be cancelled, and the Organization may allocate the indicated space to another exhibitor.
4. Once the receipt of the first payment has been received, your application to participate in EXPOSESECURITY 2026 will be fully formalized. From that moment, your Exhibitor Participation Form for EXPOSESECURITY 2026, together with this signed General Terms and Conditions document, shall constitute your exhibitor participation contract.

Seventh: Participation options, rates and basic services included

There are 2 participation options as an exhibitor at EXPOSESECURITY 2026:

7.1: Land rental + modular stand:

- Land rental + 9 m² modular stand (3x3): €2,025
 - Land rental + 18 m² modular stand (6x3): €4,050
 - Land rental + 36 m² modular stand (6x6): €6,480
- A 10% VAT must be added to the prices indicated.

The respective prices include:

- Rental of stand space open to one or more aisles depending on location
- Assembly and rental of the modular stand defined by the Organization, consisting of the following elements:
 - => Structure: modular carpentry stand
 - => Standard electrical installation and consumption
 - => Exhibition carpet
 - => Basic lettering with name
 - => Furniture:
 - 3x3: 1 counter + high table + 2 stools
 - 3x6: 1 counter + low table + 4 chairs
 - 6x6: 1 counter + low table + high table + 4 chairs + 3 stools.
 - => Assembly fee required by Exposecurity World S.L.
 - => Mandatory insurance (Civil Liability and Damage Insurance) required by Exposecurity World S.L.
 - => Passes:
 - 9 m²: 9 passes + 100 tickets
 - 18 m²: 12 passes + 100 tickets
 - 36 m²: 15 passes + 100 tickets
 - => Individual profile on the exhibitor platform
 - => Stand dismantling
 - => Initial stand cleaning

The removal by the exhibitor of any formative or decorative element of the stand shall not imply any reduction in cost.

All materials used are provided on a rental basis and any damage will be invoiced according to the current rate.

The exhibiting company must provide all graphic material necessary for the design and creation of the stand. Such material shall be delivered to the Organization three months before the Fair is held.

7.2: Free floor-space rental

- 15 m²: €2,250
- 30 m²: €4,500
- 50 m²: €7,500
- 75 m²: €11,250

The areas mentioned are provided as examples. The cost per m² is €150.

A 10% VAT must be added to the prices indicated.

The price mentioned in each case includes:

- Mandatory insurance (Civil Liability and Damage Insurance) required by Exposecurity World S.L.
- 36 m² to 150 m²: 10 passes + 100 tickets
- 150 m² to 300 m²: 15 passes + 150 tickets
- More than 300 m²: 20 passes + 200 tickets
- Standard electrical installation and consumption
- Individual profile on the exhibitor platform
- The Assembly Fee is subsidized by the fair promoter

(*) The company responsible for carrying out the assembly work for free-design stands must pay the Organization, for the services provided by Exposecurity World S.L. during the Fair assembly and dismantling period: healthcare assistance service (ATS), reduced rates for catering services, inspection of electrical installations, electricity connections and supply during assembly and dismantling, use and maintenance of painting rooms, personalized fitter assistance service and individual signage for spaces.

The technical construction regulations for free-design stands will be provided by the Organization after formalization of the contract. Any enquiries should be sent to info@exposecurity.net

The stand project must be submitted to the Organization for approval.

Eighth: Amount and method of payment

1. The exhibitor shall pay Exposecurity World S.L. the amount established according to the option selected, as indicated below (*):

- First payment: 25% + VAT (10%) upon confirmation as an exhibitor at EXPOSESECURITY 2026 and receipt of the corresponding invoice, with a deadline of June 15, 2026.
- Second payment: 25% + VAT (10%), deadline August 15, 2026.
- Third payment: 50% + VAT (10%), with a deadline of September 15, 2026.
- **All exhibitors who reach the September 15 deadline without a stand must pay 100% of the full amount on that date in order to exhibit at EXPOSESECURITY 2026**

(*) For confirmations after the deadlines indicated by tranche, the payment percentages will be accumulated as indicated by the Organization, thereby reducing the number of invoices.

8.2: Pursuant to the legislation in force on Value Added Tax, non-EU companies, non-Spanish intra-Community companies registered in the ROI (Register of Intra-Community Operators), as well as embassies, consulates and international organizations recognized by Spain, are exempt from VAT.

8.3: Payment shall be made in the name of Exposecurity World S.L. by one of the following means:

Bank transfer or account deposit in the name of the relevant company, entity, ministry or town council.

It is essential to indicate the invoice number. The payment or bank transfer receipt must be sent to the Organization by email at: info@exposecurity.net

Ninth: Failure to meet deadlines

If the aforementioned payments are not made within the established deadlines, the exhibitor shall lose all rights over the reserved spaces, as well as any amounts paid, and the Organization may assign such spaces to other companies or use them for its own purposes.

Tenth: Contracting additional services for participation

In addition to the basic services detailed in point 7 of this document, included in the price of the modular stand or free floor-space rental, any exhibitor may directly contract other services included in the EXPOSESECURITY 2026 Services Catalogue for the event, including those offered exclusively by the Pabellón de Cristal in Casa de Campo fair venue.

In accordance with current regulations, EXPOSESECURITY 2026 informs its exhibitors that their data will be transferred to Exposecurity World S.L. for the purpose of sending the Services Catalogue commercialized by the event.

If the provision of any service is requested, the data provided by the exhibitor will be incorporated into a service provider file for the purpose of managing the provision of such services.

Services offered by EXPOSESECURITY 2026 - which must be contracted directly with said entity - include: Internet, WiFi, stand cleaning, among others.

Sufficiently in advance of the event, the Organization will provide a URL prepared by EXPOSESECURITY containing the services and rates offered exclusively for this event.

- Deadline for contracting the services mentioned in the previous paragraph: thirty (30) calendar days before the start date of assembly. Exposecurity World S.L. reserves the right to reject service requests submitted after this deadline.
- If the provision of services is requested within fifteen (15) days prior to the start of assembly, during assembly or during the Fair, Exposecurity World S.L. will apply a 25% surcharge on the established rate.
- If a service is cancelled within fifteen (15) days prior to the start of assembly or during assembly or the Fair, 40% of the corresponding rate shall be paid. If a service already provided is cancelled, 100% of the cost thereof shall be paid.

Exposure World S.L. will establish goods entry control in order to grant access only to exhibitors who have previously contracted the services requested through the Services Catalogue.

Under the "Land rental + modular stand" contracting option, the additional "electrical installation" and "construction elements" services that the exhibitor wishes to add to those already included in the price must be requested directly from the Organization.

In addition, the Organization may offer the exhibitor other services, such as advertising contracting or others, which will be invoiced separately, in accordance with the established prices, and paid in full before October 1, 2026.

Eleventh: Withdrawal by the exhibitor

Once the participation application has been formalized in the manner indicated in point 6 of this document, the exhibitor's withdrawal - whether tacit or express - from participation in the Fair shall result in the loss of the amounts paid.

If the withdrawal takes place within the sixty days prior to November 5, 2026, full payment of the contracted space may be required, even if said space may subsequently be occupied by another exhibitor.

Twelfth: Exhibitor passes

The exhibitor pass is the document that accredits the holder as such, and its presentation is required for any procedure to be carried out at the Fair.

Exhibitor passes will be delivered by the Organization once the final payment has been made, and will be collected at the Fair administration office from November 3.

In order to collect the exhibitor passes, it will be necessary to prove that all payments owed to the Organization are up to date.

Thirteenth: Staff accreditation

The exhibitor, as well as the companies involved in assembly, must keep up to date with social security payments, taxes and all other labor and tax obligations provided for in current legislation.

In the event of non-compliance, any liabilities that may arise shall be assumed in full by them, and the Organization disclaims any responsibility in this regard.

Fourteenth: Assembly and dismantling

Assembly dates and times will be reported in the Exhibitor Guide.

Occupation of the space shall not be authorized and, where applicable, the modular stand shall not be handed over to any exhibitor that has not paid for it in full.

In the case of free-design stands, the exhibitor may request a quote from the Organization to extend assembly hours. Following acceptance, the corresponding invoice will be issued. Such extension shall only be effective after the payment receipt for that invoice has been sent, at least 60 days before the start of assembly of the Fair.

Once the established dismantling period has elapsed, all materials still remaining in the pavilion will be removed by Exposure World S.L., and the exhibitor shall lose any right to claim for loss or damage thereto. Likewise, the expenses related to their removal shall be borne by the exhibitor and invoiced by Exposure World S.L. according to the current rates.

Fifteenth: Stand installation and decoration

No decorative element may protrude beyond the perimeter of the stand.

The exhibitor is obliged to comply with the current provisions related to the decoration and assembly of its stand that have been indicated by the Organization. The removal or replacement by the exhibitor of any formative element of the modular stand or counters shall not imply a reduction in cost.

In modular stands or counters, all materials used, both structural and electrical, are provided on a rental basis, and any damage will be invoiced according to the current rate.

In addition, any exhibitor may contract services listed in the Catalogue within the exhibitor area, access to which will be provided by the Organization.

The exhibiting company must provide all graphic material necessary for the design and execution of the stand, where necessary. Such material shall be delivered to the Organization three months before the Fair is held.

Sixteenth: Allocation of spaces

The allocation of spaces shall be the exclusive responsibility of the Organization. To the extent possible, the sectorization of the Fair, the application date, harmony among spaces and any other circumstance contributing to the improvement of the Fair will be taken into account.

The Organization reserves the right to modify the location if exceptional circumstances so require, without this giving rise to any right to compensation for the exhibitor. In such case, an attempt will be made to assign a space with characteristics similar to those of the space initially assigned.

Seventeenth: Exhibitor obligations

1. Payment of amounts after the deadline

In the event that payment is not made within the established deadlines, the exhibitor shall lose all rights over the reserved space, and said space shall be made available to the Organization, which may offer it to other companies. In any case, occupation of the exhibition space will not be authorized until the full amount thereof has been paid, together with the corresponding services.

2. Prohibition of dangerous activities

Activities that pose an accident risk are prohibited in all areas of the fair venue. Both in relation to the exhibited objects and to the stand assembly and decoration elements, all applicable occupational risk prevention regulations must be complied with during their transport, assembly, handling, operation and dismantling.

3. Prohibition of assignment

Total or partial assignment of exhibitor rights to third parties is not permitted; such rights must belong exclusively to the persons who sign and stamp this document, unless prior authorization is granted by the Organization.

Non-compliance by the exhibitor with the obligations set out in this point shall result in the loss of rights over the assigned or unoccupied space, and said space shall be made available to the Organization, which may offer it to other applicants, without the exhibitor being entitled, under any circumstances, to compensation or any refund.

Eighteenth: Applicable regulations

1. The exhibitor must comply with all regulations applicable to participation in EXPOSESECURITY 2026, as specified in point 3 of this document.

The exhibitor shall pay particular attention to compliance with the safety rules of Exposecurity World S.L. and with those legally applicable, in accordance with national, regional and local legislation, including the current Occupational Risk Prevention Law and its implementing regulations. With regard to the specific general participation rules of Exposecurity World S.L., these will be available in the Exhibitor Guide and shall be mandatory.

2. The exhibitor declares that it is aware of and accepts the specific general participation rules of Exposecurity World S.L. for exhibitors.

18.3: In matters of data protection, and in accordance with current regulations - Organic Law 3/2018, of December 5, on the Protection of Personal Data and Guarantee of Digital Rights, which adapts Spanish legislation to Regulation (EU) 2016/679 of the European Parliament and of the Council, of April 27, 2016 - Exposecurity World S.L. informs you of the collection and processing of personal data for the purpose of handling any type of management related to the exhibitor.

The data will not be transferred to third parties, except due to legal obligation or when the provision of a service entails the need for a contractual relationship with a processor.

All exhibitors have the right to access, rectify or erase inaccurate data, request restriction of the processing of their data, and object to such processing, among other rights, by contacting the Organization by email at info@exposecurity.net

Nineteenth: Safety and cleaning rules

The Fair will have its own security and surveillance service. The Organization will ensure surveillance of the pavilions, but shall not be responsible for the materials and objects deposited at each stand or for any damage that may be suffered by objects, samples, assembly and exhibition materials before, during or after the Fair.

After the assembly period, the service roads must be kept clear. The Organization's cleaning service may remove any element located in common areas once the assembly period has ended.

Exhibiting companies are obliged to clean their stand and may contract this service through Exposecurity World S.L.

It is recommended that materials be removed at the beginning of dismantling. The Organization shall not be responsible for any uninsured material that is lost during the dismantling period.

Twentieth: Stand attendance

The exhibitor is obliged to attend its stand and remain there with the exhibited products throughout the duration of the Fair, during the official public opening hours.

Temporary closure of stands during the lunch period is not permitted; the exhibitor must arrange the corresponding shifts to ensure proper attendance.

During the days of the event, exhibitors may access their stands from 9:00 a.m. and leave them from the closing of the Fair until 7:00 p.m.

Twenty- first: Change of dates or temporary suspension due to force majeure

If, due to force majeure beyond the Organization's control, it becomes necessary to postpone the Fair to other dates within the 2026 financial year, 50% of the stand amount will be refunded.

The exhibitor shall not, under any circumstances, lose the retained 50%, as its stand will remain reserved and the retained amounts will be applied to the Fair on the new date.

If the postponement means that the Fair is delayed until 2027, 70% of the stand amount will be refunded.

The exhibitor shall not, under any circumstances, lose the retained 30%, as its stand will remain reserved and the retained amounts will be applied to the Fair on the new date.

Twenty-second: Permits and licenses

The exhibitor must hold the legally required licenses or permits for the possession, display or use of any type of goods exhibited in the assigned space, and must also submit, in due time and form, the documentation required by the Organization in cases involving weapons or real defense material or full-size replicas.

Twenty-third: Jurisdiction

This form, once the application has been formalized and has acquired binding effect, shall constitute the participation contract for EXPOSESECURITY 2026. This contract is private in nature.

For all matters that may arise in relation to the interpretation and application thereof, the parties submit to the jurisdiction of the competent Courts and Tribunals of Madrid, expressly waiving any other jurisdiction that may correspond to them.
